- Dr Ashok Kumar, President - ACRSI, called the meeting to order.
- Dr Ashok Kumar welcomed all the members.
- There were no condolences.
- Dr Roy brought to the notice of the house the minutes of the last meeting held at HOTEL WESTIN, KOLKATA on 22th September 2018. The minutes were approved.
- Dr Roy presented the secretary's report -
 - a. This year ACRSI received best section award for 2nd consecutive year, from ASI HQ.
 - b. ACRSI's journal has been launched.
 - c. We have now digital data of our members and new membership applications can now be done seamlessly through our website.
- Dr Roy informed the house about the zonal activity and read out the report.
 - a. There was a Masterclass in Proctology held in Jalandhar, Punjab, North Zone.
 - b. The CME was conducted in the East Zone at Rotary Club, Burdwan, West Bengal.
 - c. The 23rd ACRSI instructional course was conducted from April 2nd to 5th, 2019 at the auditorium of Sir Ganga Ram Hospital, Delhi.
- All the programs were well appreciated and attended. The secretary's report was accepted by all.

- Dr. Rajashekar Mohan complained about delays in postal communication but President / Secretary apprised Dr. Rajashekar that these communications are sent to all members on SMS / WhatsApp / E-mail and are displayed on Website also. So, all members should make an attempt to see it.
- Few faculties dropped out at last movement for the present program also and it was decided to avoid them for the next 3 years as faculty. Dr Niranjan Agarwal & Dr Parvez Sheikh, Org. team of this conference to submit those names to the Secretary.
- Dr Midha read out the Treasurer's report and informed the house that the total Fixed Deposit with IOB bank is Rs. 1,29,84,610 and the current balance in the IOB bank is Rs. 12,20,855. A copy of the balance sheet and the audited report was already given to all the members at start of the meeting. The auditor's report was approved by the house.
- Dr Nisar read out his Convener's report. He informed that 77 delegates attended the Delhi Instructional Course, of which there were attendees from Bangladesh and Nepal. Dr. Kumkum Singh, Dr. Ashok Gupta, Dr. Mayilvaganan, Dr. B. K. Rao & others acted as examiners. 23 students appeared in Part-I, out of which 21 candidates passed and appeared for Part-II with a candidate from previous exam. 20 candidates cleared Part-II and with them 10 candidates from previous exam appeared in Part-III and all of them cleared it. Dr. Bharat Shankar became the Gold Medallist for the said examination after securing the first rank. Dr Nisar appreciated the effort of all the faculties, examiners and local organizers to have made it a success.
- Future ACRSI events decided in the meeting were:
 - a. ACRSI Instructional Course in April Jabalpur in 2020 to be conducted by Dr. Mukesh Shrivastava
 - b. Rajashekar Mohan would conduct ACRSICON 20202 by mid-September at Mangalore.
 - c. Instructional ACRSI 2021 Course by Dr. R Kannan., Chennai.
 - d. ACRSICON 2021 at Jaipur, Rajasthan. Dr. Bhawar Yadav will be the Organizing secretary. The said conference will be conducted in collaboration with **Eurasian Colorectal Technologies Association** Congress (ECTA)
- It was proposed to shorten the instructional fellowship course to 3 days. And online teaching would be of 2 days. Also, the MCQ Part of the Exam should be conducted online. The house accepted the course duration of 3 days with the online teaching of 2 days but declined the online exam of MCQ part of the exam.
- Details of International Travelling Fellowship 2018-19

- Elections were conducted smoothly. Discussion to change agency for future elections was rejected as everyone was happy with the present agency
- Dr. Niranjana Agarwal, President Elect & Chief Election Officer, ACRSI, declared the result of recently conducted elections of ACRSI. 655 Votes were casted online for 2019-21 Session.

- b) Name will be enrolled as a member on submission of the application form duly filled and the membership fee fixed by the association is paid.

Proposed amendment

Name will be enrolled as a member on submission of the application form duly filled and the membership fee fixed by the association is paid.

Membership Application can be made online as well with uploading of all necessary documents and payment online

Accepted unanimously

- d) Each member will be issued a membership card/No.

Proposed amendment for membership document

Members will be issued a membership number and they can download the certificate from the web system online.

Accepted unanimously

- e) There will be a fee for application form, and for life membership, which will be fixed by the general body from time to time. Present membership fees Rs. 5000/-

4. By expulsion

Proposed amendment for membership cessation

- a. Member will cease to be a member of the Association on account of any misconduct, misdemeanor or any other cause deemed to be good and sufficient enough by the Managing Committee.
 - b. The MC shall have powers to SUSPEND any members from its Register for any cause or acts deemed derogatory to the dignity of the Profession and to the ACRSI
 - c. If any member ceases to be a member of asi due to whatsoever reasons
- 5 Any member who ceases to be a member of respective state medical council / medical council of India – exemption if temporarily suspended

Office bearers

Existing

- d) If no one is elected to a particular post, except for the President's post, all other posts may be filled by Executive Committee amongst themselves or from the members of good standing of the association.

Proposed amendment

If no one is elected to a particular post, except for the President's post, all other posts may be filled at the AGM after proposal from the outgoing EC and the President Elect

Accepted unanimously however such selected members from the AGM must submit the amount applicable for the respective election application. Even coopted members and other members appointed without elections (such as academic convenors, journal editor) should pay the necessary fees as paid by other committee member. Only IPP is not required to pay.

e) President Elect will be the Election officer

Proposed amendment

President Elect will be the Chief Election officer. There will be a tribunal of immediate and current president to assist the Chief Election officer. Any dispute regarding election has to be first brought to the tribunal notice through the Chief Election officer before approaching any other redressal forum. He/she can approach EC, AGM, ASI or legal remedy if not satisfied with the decision of the tribunal. Failing this, strict disciplinary action can be initiated against the defaulting candidate and his/her election candidature may be cancelled in between the elections too.

General Body Meeting

Existing

1. General body meeting must be conducted once in a year at the time of Annual conference at September.

Proposed amendment for GBM

The GBM will be conducted at the time of the annual conference on day 2 at the end of the scientific debreation at 6 pm onwards in the hall provided for the same. If any change is deemed necessary than the same should be discussed at EC and approved by it.

Election of the Office Bearers

Existing

- a. All office bearers and members of the Executive Committee are eligible for re-election, except the President.

Proposed amendment for election of the office bearers

All office bearers and members of the Executive Committee are eligible for re-election, except the President and those who have completed their eligible number of terms as defined below in their respective categories

Accepted unanimously

- b. Members must have attended at least two meetings of the association in last five years.

Proposed amendment for attendance in meetings

The members must have attended at least two meetings of the association (Acrsicon) in last five years prior to the election year and must be able to produce the attendance certificate alongwith the nomination form. For example: for the election to be held in 2021, the member must have attendance in minimum 2 conference between 2016 to 2020

Duties of the officer bearers

Proposed amendments

- Responsibilities of a joint /web secretary is to assist secretary in day to day activities of association and also write detailed daily minutes at AGM and furnish them to secretary for finalisation. In absence of secretary he acts as an acting secretary.

Post of Joint Sec/web sec not approved. Instead, the committee members to assist sec in the webwork.

- Members of the EC and fellowship board are expected not to participate as faculty in the programs of ISCP or orgainse any program under the banner of ISCP

Duties of the President

Existing

The president along with the Hon. Secretary is responsible for the overall running of the association

- g. Must ensure that all EC and VP members must do some academic activity in their zone. Failure to do so would not make them eligible to recontest election.

Accepted unanimously as Must ensure that all EC and VP members must do some academic activity in their zone.

Responsibilities of the Hon. Secretary

Existing

Hon. Secretary is responsible for the overall functioning of the association on a day to day basis

- l. To make a report and send all activities to headquarter timely. Every activity should be reported immediately to earn more points.
- m. Also timely information well in advance to person giving lecture in conference and course is essential.

Also president and secretary should identify members who habitually opt out at the last moment during course and conference and avoid them in future.

Accepted unanimously as above + avoid them in future for next 3 years

Board for Fellowship examination in coloproctology

Existing

- i. The instructional courses both should have Panel Discussion, Symposia, Floor Discussion, Lectures, Video Session and Live Demonstration. At the end of each course 'Course Attended Certificate' will be issued to every candidate who has paid for the course & attended course in full.

Proposed amendments

The duration of course has already been proposed to be reduced to three days with basic part of course material to be sent online to the candidates

- The schedule for course should be Precise and not hectic. Only the topics which are of clinical importance to be included in teaching program

The overall burden and expenses for the whole process of fellowship course and examination will be reduced not only for the association but also for the organisers and candidates

Accepted unanimously

Fellowship examination in ACRSI

Existing

h. Each candidate must pass each section of examination separately. Those who pass part-I are permitted to appear for part-II and those who have passed part I and II to be permitted for part-III

Proposed amendments

- The examination process to be completed in one day instead of two days (NO)
- The MCQ part can be held online as part one; (NO)
- Part second will consist of: a) Single paper of three-hour duration containing both short and essay type questions, b) Viva verse; (Existing)
- Part third will be clinical including short and long cases (Existing)

*This way only those who qualify part one will come for part second and third examination their by avoiding unnecessary travel and expenses; this will also reduce the stay and expenses for the examiners
(to be omitted)*

*Candidates who has cleared FACRSI exams would be expected to present one scientific article related to coloproctology in the Indian Journal of Coloproctology or any other Index Journal.
(accepted)*

Candidates who passed FACRSI will be expeted to shadow one or two eminent surgeons in the country approved by ACRSI for two weeks at least (1-week proctology and 1-week colorectal surgery).

(Points from Dr. Kumkums Singh) Since we have discussed many times about shortening of course duration and online MCQ I still feel MCQ should be conducted during the course and not online. This is my personal view. (Not necessary. In fact, they should be encouraged to apply to TF but same should not come in their way of their convocation)

The nomination form to be filled and forwarded in a sealed envelope by post or on email of the chief election officer or if online application starts in future than apply online before 30th Jun 11 pm. The fees for the same can be paid by DD alongwith hard copy application or has to be transferred to the association account before the due date and time. The candidates must produce a proof of the fees paid electronically

Rules for the Election of Office-Bearers

Existing

- 1) Nominations shall be invited on the printed proforma and the nominations shall be duly proposed and seconded by two life members of 5 years standing.

Proposed amendment for Nomination Form

Nomination form can be filled electronically, scanned filled form and send as mentioned above. Incomplete forms will be dismissed. Candidates must provide for all information in the form along with the necessary supporting documents for the same. The proposed and seconded portion may be filled in the hard copy of the form but since proposer or seconder may not be from same city, they can send an email application stating that they are proposing or seconding a particular candidate. The said email has to come from the registered email id with the acrsi of the proposer or seconder only. One can only propose or second only one candidate for whatever post he / she may be contesting. The members of the election tribunal cannot propose or second

Existing

- 2) He / she shall be eligible for re-election for one more term only if he has attended at least 2 EC meeting in the current term out of the 6 usually held or 33% of the nos of EC meeting held during his current term.

Proposed amendment for number of meetings

He / she shall be eligible for re-election for one more term only if he has attended at least 2 EC meeting in the current term out of the 5 usually held OR 33% of the nos of EC meeting held during his current term.

No member after the last GC meeting will be allowed to vote.
- b) the approved members may be allowed corrections in their data available with the ACRSI office up to 31st July of the year of the election for being eligible for voting in that elections. No corrections in the data would be permitted for that particular election after 31st July of that year
